

Dr Greg Malone MBBS (QLD), FRACS (UROL)

Consultant Urologist, Greenslopes Private Hospital; St Andrews War Memorial Hospital & Mater Private Hospital Redland, *BRISBANE*

Dr Greg Malone is a Consultant Urologist practising at Greenslopes Private Hospital, St Andrews War Memorial Hospital, Brisbane, and Mater Private Hospital Redland.

He also serves as a Senior Examiner in Urology for the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons (RACS) and Surgeon Mentor and educates and instructs fellow Urologists in the techniques and practise of surgical therapy for erectile restoration and male urinary incontinence.

Dr Malone has special interests in robotic surgery, prostate cancer pelvic uro-oncology, and the management of erectile dysfunction (ED) – (also known as impotence) – a common urological problem¹ involving the inability to achieve, and maintain a sufficient erection for sexual activity.^{2,3} He specialises in penile implants – designed to be a long-term solution⁴ implanted into the penis, offering concealed support for an erection.^{5,6}



Dr Malone was involved in the establishment of Queensland's first robotic surgery unit at Greenslopes Private Hospital – Queensland Robotic Surgery (QRS) – and a member of the surgical team involved in the State's first robotic radical prostatectomy performed. QRS has since become one of Australia's pre-eminent robotic surgical units.

He completed his Bachelor of Medicine and Surgery (MBBS) at the University of Queensland in 1992, and undertook junior medical training in Cairns and Innisfail. Dr Malone next completed his advanced surgical training in Brisbane. In 1998, he graduated with a Master of Medical Science degree from the University of Queensland, where his research focused on urinary tract cancer, with an emphasis on pathways of cancer spread (metastasis).

In 2001, Dr Malone completed his Fellowship examinations and training with the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons (RACS) (Urology). In 2002, he undertook post-Fellowship training at the prestigious Institute for Urology and Nephrology in London, focusing on prostate cancer and radical prostatectomy, prosthetic urology (penile implant and rehabilitation surgery / male incontinence), endo-urology, and the management of complex stone disease.

Dr Malone holds professional memberships and registrations at the Australian Health Practitioner Registration Authority (AHPRA) – Specialist Urologist, Fellow of RACS, Urological Society of Australia and New Zealand (USANZ), European Association of Urology (EAU), American Urological Association (AUA), The Society of Robotic Surgery (SRS), Societe Internationale d'Urologie (SIU), and Australian Medical Association (AMA).

He is former meeting Chair and convenor of the USANZ Annual Scientific Meeting between 2013-2014, Chair of the Australian and New Zealand Association of Urological Surgeons (ANZAUS) between 2011-2014, and Collagenase in Peyronie's Disease Principal Investigator at the International Multicentre Randomized Trial.

"One of the great privileges of being a doctor, is providing care to patients who have come through their cancer journey and now wish to overcome the significant quality of life impact that this treatment has caused them.

"My reconstructive skills allow me to provide this care to these men. This can take the form of both restoration of erectile function and, the return of urinary continence.

"Some of my most grateful patients are these men, and I am honoured to be able to provide these outcomes for them," said Dr Malone.
